



AUSTRALIA WIDE TEN: CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

These Conditions of Entry apply to the entry form for the *Australia Wide Ten* travelling textile art exhibition. Entries close at 5pm on 15 June 2026 Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) and entrants will be notified if their work has been selected by Tuesday 21 July. Please direct any queries to

General

1. Entry is open to all members of Ozquilt Network Inc. (OZQN).
2. Artwork subject matter is open.
3. For the purposes of this exhibition, a quilt is defined as a stitched, layered textile incorporating any material and employing any technique. However, as this is a travelling exhibition, entries that are framed, delicate or require special packing, hanging or handling arrangements are not eligible for consideration.
4. Entries must measure **40cm x 40cm** finished. A variation of up to 1cm in size is acceptable.
5. Entries must include a 7 cm hanging sleeve positioned 2 cm from the top edge of the quilt and 2cm from side edges.
6. Entries may only be submitted via the **AUSTRALIA WIDE TEN** online entry form by no later than 5pm Friday 15 June 2026 (AWST).
7. Selected works **must** be delivered to the designated delivery address shown on the artist selection notice by 1 September and be available to tour until the end of September 2028. OZQN is not obliged to release or return any work before the end of September 2028.
8. Artists may enter up to two works although only one work may be selected. Recent works are preferred.
9. All entries must be the original, non-traditional design and work of the entrant. Works made under the direction of another person, e.g. in a workshop or course, are not eligible.
10. Artwork that differs from the submitted image will not be accepted.
11. Works entered for previous Australia Wide exhibitions are not eligible.
12. The entrant gives permission for images of any selected quilt and any text accompanying the entry to be reproduced by print, electronic or any other media for publicity, catalogues and any other appropriate purposes, including exhibiting selected quilts on our website www.ozquiltnetwork.org.au
13. Title of work, artist's name and contact details must be shown on the back of the quilt.

Image Specifications

Entrants must submit one clear digital image of the textile work (including edges) in jpg format. No detail is required.

The image must be at least 2000 pixels on the longest side and the overall file size must not exceed 5MB. Please name your file with your last name, your first initial, a brief title of the work. For example: TaylorK-BriefTitleOfWork.jpg .

The quality of the digital image is important to give your work the best possible chance. Please ensure that the image accurately represents the colours of the submitted work.

Artists' Responsibilities

1. Artists will pay an ENTRY FEE of \$35 for one quilt, or \$45 for two quilts, to assist with selector and administration expenses. This fee is payable when the entry/entries is/are submitted.
 - Payment may be made by direct deposit Westpac Bank, account name: Ozquilt Network Inc., BSB 033602, Account # 136213. Include your name and the code AW10 in the transaction description.
 - Payment can also be made by credit card via PayPal (no PayPal account required).
2. Artists whose work is selected must pay an additional \$50 TOUR ADMINISTRATION FEE to assist with travel and administration expenses. This fee is payable by the due date for quilt delivery, 1 October 2026. (Payment may be made by direct deposit and must include your name and the code AW10 in the transaction description. Payment may also be made by PayPal.)
3. Selected artists will also be responsible for the cost of shipping the work to OZQN and all shipping costs associated with returning the artwork to the artist for rectification if the hanging sleeve does not comply with the instructions.
4. Insurance cover, if desired, is the responsibility of the artist.
5. The artist warrants that the textile work is their own original design and indemnifies OZQN against any claim for breach of copyright.
6. Selected artists are expected to maintain their OZQN membership for the duration of the exhibition tour and, wherever practicable, to attend AW10 exhibition openings and tour events.

OZQN Responsibilities:

1. OZQN and exhibiting galleries endeavour to take all due care whilst the textile works are in our possession, notwithstanding, OZQN is not liable for any loss or damage to the works however such loss or damage is caused. OZQN cannot provide insurance for the selected works. Insurance is the responsibility of each artist for their respective works.
2. OZQN reserves the right to retain a digital record of images of selected quilts, plus accompanying text, for archival, educational, promotional or other appropriate purposes.
3. Quilts may be offered for sale, with sold quilts remaining with the exhibition until after the close of the tour. OZQN will not be directly responsible for the sale of quilts. However, all enquiries will be passed to exhibitors. The artist must promptly notify OZQN of any sale and pay OZQN a commission of 20% on all sales resulting from exhibition(s) and website exposure.
4. OZQN website and gallery material will display artist email address or website unless the artist indicates otherwise on the entry form.
5. Exhibition venues and the OZQN website will include notification that all works and text displayed are subject to copyright law. OZQN will not be responsible for any damage or loss suffered due to infringement of copyright.
6. OZQN will pay the return postage to Australian addresses at the end of AW10 touring schedule (subject to conditions outlined in artist acceptance letter). Overseas artists must contact AW10@ozquiltnetwork.org.au to discuss suitable arrangements.
7. OZQN will return the textile works to the owners by 30 September 2028.

Timeline:

- 30 March 2026: online entry form opens
- 15 June 2026: entries close at 5pm AWST
- 21 July 2026: final date for notification of selection entries
- 1 September 2026: final date for delivery to the OZQN designated representative
- 12 November 2026 to 9 January 2027 exhibition premiere at Warwick Art Gallery, Warwick, Queensland
- 30 September 2028: latest date for return of textile works to artists
